In furtherance of mutual goals to foster internationalization of education, officials from the above-named institutions hereby express their intent to collaborate.


Based upon discussions held beginning in 2015-2016 and visits by Drs. Gwendolyn Benson, Gholnecsar Muhammad, Susan Ogletree, Kristi Swafford, and Sue Duncan to Cape Town, hosted by Mr. Saadiq Albertyn, the two institutions have identified the following areas of common educational interests: exchanges of information, personnel, and technological innovations, including exchanges of teachers to lead workshops and participate in the sharing of teaching methods and strategies. Additional common interests include the goal of creating exchanges of secondary, undergraduate and graduate students (pursuant to existing Travel Warning policies at either or both universities); exchanges and visits by non-teaching and post-graduate fellows as well as junior and senior faculty members; exchange of information and graduate students in educational areas of interest; joint conferences and academic programs; and joint research activities and publications.


Specific details for implementing the above collaborations will be developed mutually and reflected in follow-on agreements to be negotiated and signed by authorized individuals from each institution.

This letter shall not constitute a binding agreement and is expressly contingent upon execution of a Memorandum of Cooperation (MOC) and/or a Program-Specific Agreement (PSA) by and between the Board of Regents of the University System of Georgia by and on behalf of Georgia State University and 2 Oceans Education Foundation.


