Letter of Intent to Collaborate
Between
Board of Regents of the University System of Georgia
By and on Behalf of
Georgia State University (“ Georgia State”) and its J. Mack Robinson College of Business
(“RCB”), Atlanta, United States of America
And
Universidad Anáhuac México Norte (“Anáhuac”) and its Faculty of Actuarial Sciences
Huixquilucan, Mexico

In furtherance of mutual goals to foster internationalization of education, officials from the above-named institutions hereby express their intent to collaborate at the college level.

Based upon a series of discussions held between representatives from RCB and Anáhuac, the two institutions commit to continue their dialogue on identifying areas of common interests to expand the extent of their relationship. Both institutions agree to explore the following areas of potential collaboration:


- I. To increase visibility of graduate programs at Georgia State, more specifically RCB Masters Programs, among alumni of Anáhuac;
- II. Exchange of academic faculty and staff members for the purpose of research, teaching and the presentation of special courses in their fields of specialization. Georgia State faculty will be subject to the procedures in Georgia State’s Travel Warning Policy;
- III. To facilitate academic programs or instruction to Anáhuac students, which may include hosting Anáhuac students at RCB for short visits, or offering guest lectures via distance-learning platforms;
- IV. Research collaborations and joint publications, addressing issues common to both institutions; and
- V. Organization of conferences, seminars and symposia of mutual interest to the institutions.

Specific details for implementing the above collaborations will be developed mutually and reflected in follow-on agreements to be negotiated and signed by authorized individuals from each institution.

This letter shall not constitute a binding agreement and is expressly contingent upon execution of an MOU and/or a Program-Specific Agreement by and between Georgia State and Anáhuac.


