



GENERAL AGREEMENT OF ACADEMIC COOPERATION
Between
CHUNGNAM NATIONAL UNIVERSITY,
DAEJEON, REPUBLIC OF KOREA
And
BOARD OF REGENTS OF THE UNIVERSITY SYSTEM OF GEORGIA BY AND ON
BEHALF OF GEORGIA STATE,
ATLANTA, UNITED STATES OF AMERICA

In recognition of their common interests in developing bilateral relations and convinced that cooperation between institutes of higher learning contributes to cultural enrichment, scientific progress, and the consolidation of friendship between countries, Chungnam National University (hereinafter "CNU"), Daejeon, Republic of Korea, and Board of Regents of the University System of Georgia by and on behalf of Georgia State University (hereinafter "Georgia State" or "GSU"), Atlanta, Georgia, United States of America, agree to revive their relationship and establish the following Agreement of Academic Cooperation.

I

This agreement may promote activities in the following areas:

- Exchange of students
- Exchange of faculty and administrative staff
- Collaborative research projects, lectures, symposia, seminars, workshops, etc.
- Short-term non-credit and for-credit Study Abroad programs
- Exchange of academic credits, information and materials
- Collaboration in instructional and cultural programs, including publication activities of mutual interests and shared access to information networks.

Please note: Georgia State's Travel Advisory Policy governs international travel by Georgia State students, faculty and staff. Travel must be approved by specified Georgia State administrators.

II

This MOC is designed to facilitate development of mutually beneficial exchanges/programs and to promote research and educational relationships, and should not be deemed to create legal and financial relationships between the parties.

Before any of the activities referenced above in Paragraph I may be implemented, both parties shall negotiate details and resolve the issues involved therewith and enter into an agreement pertaining to that activity ("Program Specific Agreement"). The term of such Program Specific Agreements shall not extend beyond five years in length. Each such Program Specific Agreement shall be subject to the availability of any resources required for the activity; provided, however, in the event financial commitments are stated, the term of such agreements may not extend beyond one year in length.

Specific mechanisms for the implementation of cooperative and collaborative activities shall be established and described in writing by the responsible authority of each institution prior to the initiation of any program or activity.

III

1. All activities developed under the auspices of this Agreement will comply with the procedures, policies, and practices of each institution as well as the law and regulations of the host country.
2. Both institutions acknowledge that the visit by faculty and students from one institution to the other shall be subject to the entry and visa regulations of each country and shall comply with the regulations and policies of CNU and Georgia State.

IV

1. This Agreement is established for a period of five years, effective on the date of its signing by official representatives of both institutions.
2. This MOC is written in English.
3. Each party shall designate a person or office to serve as liaison for the relationship established by this MOC.

Either party may change its own designated liaison by sending written notice to the other party of such change.

4. Both parties subscribe to a policy of equal opportunity and do not discriminate on the basis of race, color, gender, age, ethnicity, religion, national origin, or disability unrelated to an individual's ability to perform the duties of a particular job or position.

V


1. At the end of each five-year period, this Agreement may be renewed by mutual written agreement for additional five-year terms. A minimum period of six months' notice will be required from either party wishing to terminate the Agreement. In the event of termination, all commitment to students participating in programs will be honored by relevant parties.
2. This document constitutes the entire agreement between the parties and all prior discussions, agreements and understandings between the parties, whether verbal or in writing, are superseded by this MOC. This MOC may be amended only by means of a written instrument signed by authorized representatives of both parties.




