In accordance with Section 2 of the above-referenced agreement, Georgia State and Heidelberg elect to extend the Agreement term for five years, commencing on July 5, 2017.

However, in order to restore balance from the previous agreement term where Georgia State sent one more student than Heidelberg has sent, Georgia State will accept one additional student (or the equivalent of 33 Georgia State credits).

It is understood that all other terms and conditions shall continue in full force and effect.
