In furtherance of mutual goals to foster internationalization of education, officials from the above-named institutions hereby express their intent to collaborate.

Based upon discussions held between the leadership team of SLIIT and Dr. Denish Shah, Director of the M.S. in Marketing Program at Georgia State University, during May 2018 to December 2018, the two universities have identified the exploration of the following areas of common educational interests: (a) undergraduate students of SLIIT (upon completion of their four-year bachelor's degree) advancing to Georgia State's M.S. in Marketing program and (b) graduate students from the 2-year business program of SLIIT advancing to Georgia State's M.S. in Marketing program after completion of their first year at SLIIT. Georgia State's Travel Advisory Policy governs international travel by Georgia State students, faculty and staff. Travel must be approved by specified Georgia State administrators.

Specific details for implementing the above collaborations will be developed mutually and reflected in follow-on agreements to be negotiated and signed by authorized individuals from each institution. This letter shall not constitute a binding agreement and is expressly contingent upon execution of a Memorandum of Cooperation (MOC) and/or a Program Specific Agreement (PSA) by and between the Board of Regents of the University System of Georgia by and on behalf of Georgia State University and SLIIT.
